Each manuscript should contain a short abstract of no more than 200 words and also a primary classification number from the American Mathematical Society's 2000 Mathematics Subject Classification Scheme. The style and arrangement of the paper should conform to current practice in the Proceedings.

Authors should include, in their covering note, a suggestion of an appropriate Subject Editor from the list of Board Members.

Authors are encouraged to use TeX or LaTeX to prepare their papers.

Once an article has reached its final form and is accepted for publication, authors will be asked to supply a TeX/LaTeX file for the paper (if available). This should be a single file, with any relevant macros included in the preamble. Figures in PostScript form are also welcome, and should be submitted at the same time as the TeX file for the paper (in zipped format if appropriate).

One proof is supplied, which should be corrected and returned promptly. Excessive corrections may be charged to authors. Authors will receive a pdf of the final article.
